Enjoy two guided tours at the Missouri History Museum. ***Beyond the Ballot: St. Louis and Suffrage*** showcases women who made an impact in St. Louis before gaining the vote in 1920. Through an engaging mix of artifacts, images, media, and interactives, *Beyond the Ballot* explores women's unique roles in St. Louis history. ***St. Louis Sound*** showcases how St. Louis just can't stay quiet and it's time to raise a loud voice about its contributions to American popular music. This exhibit serves as your introduction to that music—it can't cover everything, but inside you'll find familiar tunes, deeper cuts, and a new musical outlook on the city you love. So lend the city your ears. We guarantee you'll hear something incredible. In addition to the guided tours, Sharon Smith (Curator of Civic and Personal Identity) will host a Curator Talk entitled ***The World's Fair in Photographs***. This presentation explores the planning and construction of the 1904 World's Fair, as well as what visitors to the Fair would have experienced, all through the photographs in the Missouri Historical Society Collections. Finally, attendees will have time to explore the museum on their own and visit the gift shop.
