While the U.S. Capitol is closed to the public, the U.S. Capitol Historical Society is providing a virtual tour of the U.S. Capitol showing photos and describing the experience along with the commentary of Public Historian and Chief Guide Steve Livengood. This virtual tour will show and describe the experience of the major rooms in the Most Famous Building in the World, such as the Rotunda, National Statuary Hall, the Old Senate Chamber, Old Supreme Court Chamber, the Crypt, the Brumidi Corridors, and the current House and Senate Chambers.

Mr. Livengood first started working in and giving tours of the Capitol in 1965, witnessing nearly a quarter of the 220 years that the Congress has met in Washington. He has worked with the Society for more than 25 years to fulfill our Congressionally-chartered mission to “foster an informed patriotism”. He has a B.A. in Political Science from American University and was a Ph.D. candidate in Recent U.S. Political and Social History at Emory University.
